

Dealing with Aggressive Parents



In Stoborough Nursery's Welcome Pack parents are requested to behave in a polite and appropriate manner when dropping off or collecting their children. They are informed that failure to do so could lead to their children being excluded from the group. Below are the procedures Nursery staff will follow if a parent is acting in an aggressive way towards staff, volunteers or children at Stoborough Nursery:

- The person dealing with the parent will remind them that per their parental agreement that they need to behavior in a polite and appropriate manner or they will be asked to leave the nursery and their child may be excluded.
- A second member of staff will look after the unaccompanied children at nursery
- If the parent continues to behave in an aggressive manner they will be told to leave the nursery premises.
- If the refuse to do so they will be told that we will be calling the police to ask them to leave.
- A third member of staff will dial 999 and ask for the police. They will inform
 the police that there is a disturbance at Stoborough Nursery involving an
 aggressive person and we are concerned for the staff and children's safety.
- The person calling the police will give them the follow information which is listed on the wall next to the nursery mobile.
