The aims and objectives of Stoborough Nursery are:

- ❖ To enhance the development and education of children under statutory school age;

- ❖ To prepare children for the transition from Nursery to School;

UNCRC Article 28 – Right to Education

- ❖ To continually review and enhance the provision provided to ensure a service that is responsive to the needs of children and families.

UNCRC Article 29 – Goals of Education, UNCRC Article 30 – Children of Minorities

- ❖ To promote the United Nations Convention of the Rights of the Child with all users of our nursery including: children, parents, practitioners and committee members.

UNCRC Article 3 – Best Interests of the Child

N.B. The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) sets out Welfare and Learning and Development Requirements which must be followed by providers of care for children from the age of birth until they enter compulsory education (0 to 5 years).

UNCRC – United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child – an international treaty which sets out the rights of every person under 18 and how those rights should be met.
